Tanya Gill, the International Museum of Surgical Science's 2023 Spring Artist in Residence, invites you to contribute to her upcoming exhibition at the IMSS this Fall titled ***Mend...*** You can contribute by either donating or lending loved broken objects from your home. Gill's exhibit *Mend...* will both celebrate and question acts of repair. The exhibit will consist of broken objects from domestic settings as well as from the museum's collection. Select objects will have visible, unique repairs.

Your object should be no larger than 12 inches cubed. Fabric and cloth can be folded to this size. The material can be plastic, glass, metal, fabric, ceramic, or paper. When dropping off or mailing your object to the Museum, please indicate if your object is a donation or on loan for the exhibit. If on loan, include a way to reach you. All objects on loan will be returned at the end of the exhibit.
